### **Electronic reporter's transcripts from San Diego County temporarily DELAYED**

Division One informs us that the San Diego County superior court's plan to use electronic (rather than paper) versions of reporter's transcripts for appellate records has been delayed while the court determines some of the technical details, such as the form in which the transcripts will be delivered to counsel. Reporter's transcripts will remain in paper form temporarily.

### **TrueFiling to begin June 6 in Division Two**

On Monday, June 6, TrueFiling will begin in Division Two. [Local rule 5](#),<sup>2</sup> currently designated Division One only, will then cover Division Two, as well. [ADI's announcement](#) of TrueFiling is now generic, applying where TrueFiling is used in the Fourth District. The announcement has links to guides and support for TrueFiling.
