ON REPLACEMENT OF FAX-FILING WITH E-FILING
April 1, 2014

The Fourth Appellate District is concluding its fax-filing program and replacing it with e-filing. The documents previously authorized for fax-filing may now be e-filed, instead. Those relevant to criminal and juvenile practitioners include:

Attorney General/County Counsel full concession letter

Change of address

Juvenile:

- Full concession letter by County Counsel
- Rule 5.661 appointment of minor's counsel recommendation

Request for publication of an unpublished opinion under rule 8.1120

Request for oral argument

Service copy of record correction letter to superior court under rule 8.340

Request for extension of time

Stipulation for immediate issuance of the remittitur

The court is in the process of changing its website. That will be the source of official information.
